HOW TO USE THE **RUG DOCTOR MACHINE**





- 1. Press For Spray
- Handle Release
- 3. On / Off Carpet / Upholstery Switch
- 4. Dome Filter
- 5. Dirty Water Tank
- 6. Clean Water Tank

How to Use: **FILLING THE CLEAN WATER TANK**



On the back of the machine double check the **HOSES** are securely attached.



Access the Clean Water Tank

Pull dome wire down and remove white **DIRTY WATER BUCKET,** set bucket aside.



Fill the Clean **Water Tank**

Mix cleaning solution with hot tap water; pour mixed solution into lower red **CLEAN WATER TANK.**



Now You're Ready to Clean

Replace the white **DIRTY WATER BUCKET** and secure wire over dome.



CLEANING YOUR CARPETS



Plug in the Machine

Insert plug into a properly grounded outlet.



sure the machine is in the "off" position.



Cleaning Your Carpets

Slide the switch to "Carpet". Turn on machine.

To clean, press and hold red **SPRAY** button while slowly pulling backwards

Press and release red button before ending each cleaning pass.



Tilt back to move forward, overlap cleaning passes 2-3 inches.

How to Use: **EMPTYING DIRTY WATER TANK**



Locate the Dirty Water Tank

The **DIRTY WATER TANK** is the tank located on the front of the machine.

When pump sound increases, **CLEAN WATER TANK** is empty. Unplug machine and remove white **DIRTY WATER TANK** to empty. Refill CLEAN WATER TANK.



How to Use: UPHOLSTERY TOOL



Attaching Tool to Machine

Large hose: Lift to disconnect the hose (A) and re-connect to the hose (B) from the Upholstery Tool.

Small hose: Push the textured metal ring (C) in while pulling the hose (D) out, insert tube from the Upholstery Tool (E)





Fill the Clean Water Tank

CLEAN WATER TANK.

Mix cleaning solution with hot tap water; pour mixed solution into lower red



Slide switch to "TOOL"



1. Vacuum area thoroughly.

- 2. Attach tool to the machine.
- 3. Prepare the machine fill tank and formula as per previous directions.
- 4. Turn on the machine by pressing the "ON" switch for **UPHOLSTERY/** HAND TOOL cleaning on the top of the machine.
- 5. Test upholstery for colorfastness by first cleaning a small, hidden area, then rubbing the test area with a white paper towel. If no color appears, continue cleaning.
- 6. Clean by squeezing the hand tool lever as you pull the tool backwards over area to extract dirty water.



Prepare Machine to return to store:



To avoid Cleaning Fee follow these steps

1. Unplug machine.

- 2. Remove and empty the **DIRTY WATER TANK.** Rinse and let dry. **CLEAN WATER TANK**
- 3. Remove hair and debris from bottom of machine and brush roll.
- 4. Wipe down bottom
- 5. Put **DIRTY WATER TANK** back onto machine and return machine to the store.

Note: Do NOT spray machine with hose or immerse in water at any time

- **DO NOT** immerse. Use only on surfaces moistened by the cleaning process
- **DO NOT** use machine as a vacuum.

 This machine is designed to clean normally soiled carpets in two (2) cleaning passes, except Berber multi-level or looped carpets.
- **DO NOT** use more than four (4) cleaning passes on any area of carpet as overwetting and damage may result which could include permanent
- staining of carpet.

 Use caution when using hot tap water. Do not boil or microwave water to be used in this machine. **DO NOT** allow the machine to run dry. When the solution tank runs out.
- stop using and follow directions to refill. **DO NOT** allow this machine to be used as a toy. Close attention and adult
- supervision is necessary when used by or near children. This machine is not intended to be used by children age 12 and under.
- **DO NOT** allow children to place their body parts in or near openings or **DO NOT** use with damaged cord or plug. If this machine is not working as
- it should, has been damaged by dropping or has been left outdoors; stop **DO NOT** pull by the cord, carry by the cord, use the cord as a handle, close
- a door on the cord, nor pull the cord around sharp edges or corners. **DO NOT** run machine over the cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.

GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

This appliance must be grounded. If it should malfunction or break down, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This appliance is equipped with a cord that has an

equipment-grounding conductor and grounding plug. The plug must be inserted into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.
